- Adams in Motion (AIM)**
Students have the opportunity to run the AIM track during morning recess 3 mornings a week. Volunteers punch cards for students who run/walk laps. (T, W, TH)
Once a week for 20 minutes
- Art@Adams** (Art Show/Cards & Magnets)
Our Art program is supported through a combination of school funds, APT funds, and direct donations. Cards & Magnets made from your student's artwork are available to purchase during the year. An Art Show is traditionally held in spring.

- Adams Wear**
Adams APT has designed t-shirts & sweatshirts. Items are usually available by pre-order. This is NOT a fundraiser; this is to show our ALLIGATOR PRIDE!

- APT (Adams Parent-Teacher Org)**
APT is the Adams Elementary PTO group. We have monthly meetings (w/free child care). All parents and teachers are members and are encouraged to attend.
Minimum of 2 hours per month
- Adams Auction**
40 minute increments available
- Block Party**
40 minute increments available
- Book Fair**
APT hosts two fundraising book fairs during the school year, in Fall and Spring.
40 minute increments available
- Box Tops for Education**
APT coordinates two Box Tops drives during the school year (fall and spring). Please save and clip all year 'round.
2-3 hours per collection drive
- Carnival**
Games, bouncy houses, food, and prizes make this a great FREE family event.
30 min – 2 hours total
- Child Care Swap:**
Volunteer in an onsite childcare room for younger siblings to allow more parents to volunteer in classrooms.
30 minutes of prep/30 min event shifts
- Dine Out for Adams**
Organize and advertise Dine Out dates with local restaurants & Adams gets a % of the proceeds. 2-5 hours per year
- Direct Donation Drive**
2-5 hours per year
- E-Scrip**
E-Scrip is another free money fundraiser. Register your Safeway card and credit or grocery cards online, and a % of your spending will go to Adams each time you use your card. Visit www.escrip.com to sign up.
- Family Reading Night**
A family "read-in" in the gym held during the week of Dr. Seuss's birthday and Read Across America week in March.
30-60 minutes of prep
- Field Day**
Held during the last week of school. Students have fun playing games outside.
30 minute time slots
- Garden Club/School Gardening**
Student, parent & staff volunteers care for our school garden or various needs that arise
Flexible: As much or as little as you'd prefer
- General Volunteer**
Our APT is looking for volunteers who are willing to be contacted as needs arise (Bake sales, data entry, fundraising, etc.).

- Harvest Festival**
Games, food, and crafts make this a great FREE family event.
30 min – 2 hours total
- Health Screening**
All students receive vision and dental screenings in the Fall. Volunteers assist with escorting students to the screening location.
2-5 hours total
- Jog-a-thon**
This is a winter fundraising event. Kids earn money for their school by running laps around the gym. Donations from family members and friends are then given based on how many laps were run by their student.
30 minute time slots
- Office Help/Volunteer Center**
Volunteers sign up to help as needed in the office as well as maintain the volunteer center.
One day each month for 30-60 minutes
- Reader Board**
A volunteer is needed to update the reader board with school events and reminders.
Once a month for 15-30 minutes
- Room Parents**
30-60 minutes total
- School Pictures**
Student photographs/retakes are taken in the Fall. Volunteers assist with escorting students to picture location.
1-4 hours total
- Scrip**
Fundraiser: APT buys merchant gift cards at a discount (3-25% off) and resells them at face value. There is no extra expense for the user, but Adams earns \$ on each card sold. Scrip is sold after school, or pre-ordered and picked up at the office. Volunteers assist with sales.
30 minutes per week or month
- Sock Hop**
Come dance in the gym with all your friends and family! Hula-hoop competitions, lots of great music, fun and refreshments make this a fantastic family event.
30 min – 2 hours total
- Staff Appreciation**
Volunteers provide staff with meals/treats/tasks during the year and contribute to the end of year staff appreciation luncheon.
Involves food prep/donation
- Technical/Online/Graphic Design**
2-3 hours total
- Walk/Bike to School Day**
Each year, Adams School promotes safe routes to school by celebrating International Walk to School Day in October as well as the first Wednesday each month.
30-60 minutes/ 1-10 times a year
